**Awards at Classic:** All swimmers are divided into two tiers with the faster swimmers in the first tier and the slower in the second. (Exception: 6 & unders have three tiers.) Ribbons are given to tier winners, not heat winners. For individual events in each tier, medals are give for 1<sup>st</sup> – 4<sup>th</sup> place and ribbons are given for 5<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> place. In relay events, medals are given to each member of the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place teams and ribbons are given to each member of the 3<sup>rd</sup> through 6<sup>th</sup> place teams.
