Farmstead Parking

Taking a stab that parking rules are the same as last years, please read the following lifted surreptiously from last year's newsletter:

"We just learned this morning of some new parking restrictions established by the City on the streets by Farmstead. 'No Parking' signs are being posted along the west side of FairOak Drive. Also, there is no parking along the North side of Mill Race between Indian Trail and Indian Knoll, and along the South side of Mill Race eastward from the pool down to Fender. In the past, Naperville Police have also ticketed for parking too close to intersections, blocking fire hydrants, parking too close to the edge of driveways, etc.

We recommend parking at Madison Jr High School. It is a short walk to the pool. Please be sure to advise and remind all your swimming families of this. Thanks!"

Fascinating Facts about the Classic Meet

Awards at Classic: All swimmers are divided into two tiers with the faster swimmers in the first tier and the slower in the second. (Exception: 6 & unders have three tiers.) Ribbons are given to tier winners, not heat winners. For individual events in each tier, medals are given for 1st – 4th place and ribbons are given for 5th – 8th place. In relay events, medals are given to each member of the 1st and 2nd place teams and ribbons are given to each member of the 3rd through 6th place teams.

Classic Practice Time: Tuesday, July 19: 1 – 2pm at Neuqua High School.

Classic Warm-ups: Saturday, July 23: 7 – 7:25am, Lane 8, at Neuqua High School.

The Classic Meet is expected to end around 12:30pm.

Conference Championship T-Shirts

At about this time last year, the Park District was offering swimmers a chance to pre-order Conference T-shirts. 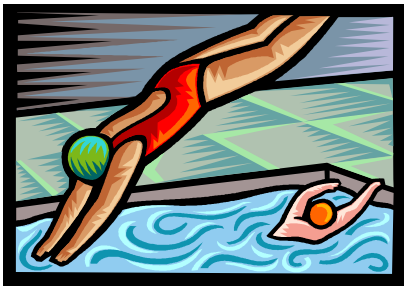

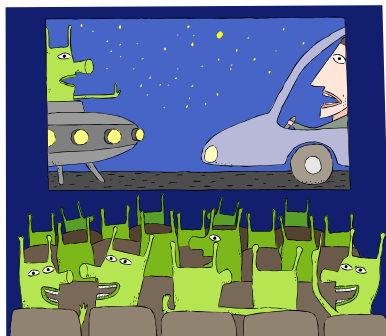
